





Library for inmates at former Kingston Penitentiary in 2015.

Incarceration in Saskatchewan

Saskatchewan's incarceration rate higher than national average

- 222.5 per 100k vs 71.5 per 100k
- 19 correctional facilities in SK
 - 4 federal and 14 provincial
- 2,121 incarcerated individuals
 - 74 incarcerated youth
- Indigenous overrepresentation
 - federally and provincially
