- Saskatchewan Court of King's Bench (SKKB)
  - Serious criminal matters, most family law matters, and civil claims over \$30,000

- Saskatchewan Provincial Court (SKPC)
  - Most criminal matters, youth matters, small claims, traffic tickets, bylaws, and some family matters


