



 - Includes mistakes and missteps
 - Has multiple starts and stops
 - Isn't static
 - Is rarely complete after the first attempt


Tip: Learn to use online and offline resources in tandem.

Tip: Choose the best **primary law** resource.

- Commercial resources exceed free resources in terms of the digital commentary content available.





Scenario Demonstration

- Our Scenario:
 - Children live with parent A, who works M-F.
 Parenting schedule is based on Parent B's shiftwork schedule. The result is instability for the child and custodial parent, as parenting time is not coordinated to parent's work schedule.
 Would the current law in Saskatchewan support a change to this arrangement?



Scenario

- Keyword Search Strategy:
 - Step 1: Brainstorm for keywords
 - Step 2: Identify concepts
 - Step 3: Create search query
 - Step 4: Analyze results
 - Step 5: Reformulate search
